## Notice to the Parents

Dear parents, as per the guidelines of the District Administration and Disaster Management, Government of Jharkhand, we are planning to reopen school for our students of classes 6-8 from 4<sup>th</sup> October 2021. However, we would like to follow the covid protocol and therefore, students will be called to school according to the following scheme: -

Classes will be held according to the following scheme:

The daily routine will now be referred in terms of numbers instead of days, i.e., MONDAY routine will now be known as 'DAY - 1' routine, TUESDAY routine as DAY - 2 routine and so on.

The week from Monday to Saturday will have 3 DAYS routine, namely, DAY - 1 [Monday & Tuesday] DAY - 2 [Wednesday & Thursday] and DAY - 3 [Friday & Saturday]. The 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> day routine will roll over to the next week.

Students bearing **roll numbers 1-33** of each class (6-8) and sections (A, B, C, D) will come to school on **Monday, Wednesday and Friday, [MWF]** whereas students bearing roll numbers **34 onwards** will attend classes at school on **Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday [TTS]**.

We would also expect your cooperation in conducting the offline classes as far as counselling of children regarding the strict observation of the covid protocols are concerned. To state it in simple words, please provide your child with personal had sanitizer, counsel him to keep his mask on every time and maintain proper social distance; not to share food or water with anyone while in school. Kindly explain to him that his personal safety is of prime importance.

We, at school, are already observing the strictest of care with the students presently coming to school. Right from the time the children board the bus, they will have to undergo thermal scanning and will be provided with hand sanitizers. Again, at the school gate, they will be scanned once again and hand sanitizers will be provided.

The school building has handsfree sanitizer dispensers installed at different places. The school canteen shall remain closed according to the guidelines from the district administration. The same guidelines issued


by the administration also prohibit students from carrying tiffin to school, therefore, we request you to kindly give them a heavy breakfast before they come for class.

Personal hand sanitizers; water bottles to be carried from home.

Children will be sent back at 12:00 p.m. so you may expect him home latest by 12:45 p.m. (depending on traffic conditions.)

Before you send your ward to the school, we would like you to fill the CONSENT FORM which may be downloaded from the school website and submitted to the class teacher on the day you come to submit the answer scripts of your ward.

We expect your cooperation to help our children to come back to their normal life.
